

ANAGRAM

Description

The aim is to think of words, using letters taken out from a longer word. You will have a time limit and do it in a small group, so that there is competitiveness between you.



Time Needed

10 min

Learning Setting

Individual or group activity

Materials Required



- The word written on a paper or blackboard in front of you
- Sheets of paper to write
- Pens/pencils, Timer

Practical Tips

There could be a lot of modifications, simply changing the word, out of which the participants have to make out shorter words.

Expected Results

- You will have to recall words (training memory), move words from passive vocabulary into active one.
- You will train logical thinking
- You will practice attention concentration

Step By Step Guidance

You have to make up words, using the letters of the word written in front of you (on the board, or on the sheets of paper). The word is the following:

CONSTITUTIONALITY

Possible answers:

tuition, son, sun, cat, can....

The timer will be set for 10 minutes.

After the time is gone, the moderator will provide an acoustic signal that the time is over. Everyone will count how many words that have written, and determine the winner. Everyone will read the words they have written.
