

SING ON

Description

This song-related activity asks you to find songs that contain specific words.

Learning Objectives

- Train the memory
- Enhance social participation

Step By Step Guidance

First, the first participant sings a song and then suddenly stops.

The other participants should then recall or write down as many songs that include the word that the first participant stopped at.

The second round begins with another participant starting a new song and stopping to a new word.

Expected Results

- Recall as many songs as possible
- Social interaction

Materials Required

Paper and pens/pencils might be needed

Practical Tips

- Those who do not wish to sing can also recite the songs.
- Another alternative is for the first participant to stop and then the next person to start singing the next line of that song. In this alternative, only people who know the song can participate in each round.
- A more difficult alternative is that the second participant should start a new song from the word the first participant stopped at. As an example, if the first participant stopped singing after the word heart, the second should begin singing another song from the moment the word heart is mentioned. The second participant should stop singing at a new word. The third participant should start singing another song from the word the second participant stopped at etc.
