A Project Update

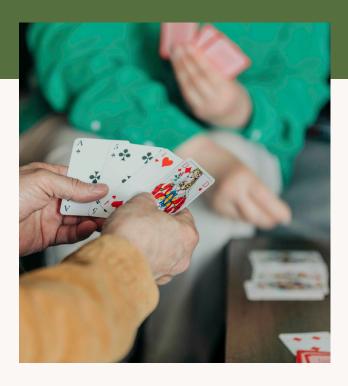
